FREE RADON KITS

The Bristol Burlington Health District (BBHD) is participating in National Radon Action Month by distributing free radon test devices to their residents during the month of January and February 2015.

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas that is a product of the uranium decay chain. It is an odorless, colorless, tasteless and inert gas. Long-term exposure to high levels of radon gas increases the risk of developing lung cancer. The CT DPH recommends that all homes be tested for radon gas and to mitigate homes when airborne radon is equal to or greater than 4 pCi/L. A homeowner's first priority should be to test for radon in the air. If your home is served by a private well, you should also test for radon in the water.
